As well as looking good, the building erected by the main contractor on-site, Casey builders of Shetland also worked well from a practical standpoint. The internal steelwork is stronger than conventional industrial units and this really helps to keep everything safe and secure. Should there be any adverse weather conditions the 4m x 4m insulated roller door will provide maximum protection.
